

Photoshoot Guide

Sit Stay Capture
The Adventure Dog Photographer

LOCATION

Unless otherwise agreed your photoshoot will take place at Druridge Bay Country Park in Northumberland. The miles of coastline lend themselves to sea, sand and sunshine (if we are lucky with the weather). Clients meet in the car park down by the cafe, it's easy to find just follow the road all the way through the park keeping the lake on your left.

The postcode for the park is NE61 5BX - and it's well signposted. I'll be in either a van plated K9 RXA or car JE04RLE. I recommend arriving 10 minutes early so you've got a chance to get parked, get your bearings and also gives your dog/dogs a chance to settle in the new space before the shoot. The first hour is free in the car park and £1.20 after that; most photoshoots will fall within the one hour.

ON THE SHOOT

1. Make sure you bring your dogs favourite toys, high value treats and anything else you'd normally take on a walk. Sometimes dogs are extra excited if it's somewhere they've never been before. Longlines often don't work well for photoshoots so if your dog is likely to need one please get in touch beforehand.
2. Depending on the weather and tide times we will usually start on the dunes and beach, if we have enough time we will then move onto the lake setting in the park. In the summer the lake can sometimes have algae which means I would usually recommend not visiting that area. (don't worry it's nowhere near the beach)
3. I'll take action and portrait shots - using a mixture of recall games between owners and if they like toys - having the toy thrown at me.
4. If your dog likes the water let me know so we can ensure we get some dry shots first!
5. Don't forget your photoshoot is just like a normal walk for your dog, just I'm tagging along!

AFTER THE SHOOT

I'll spend the next few days editing each image individually until there are around 70 ready for your gallery. I'll usually get images back to you within 10 days. Once uploaded you'll get an email with a PIN. This is used to download the entire album straight to your computer. All of the images are high resolution and un-watermarked. These are yours to print, share and show off as you wish. I often use DSColourLabs for products and prints.

PAYMENT

Payment can be made via cash on the day, or via bank transfer when your gallery is delivered via email. Account details will be on the email.

OTHER INFORMATION

- If you have more than one dog and would like group portrait shots it's worth practising well before the photoshoot, in the house, garden and then out on walks. Things like recall practice also help when it comes to getting the best shots of your dog. If your dogs don't have a sit stay it's unlikely they will sit as a group. Single dog portraits are a little easier if your dog doesn't have a stay.
- Collars and harnesses. Think about whether you want your dog in a harness or what sort of collar you'd like them to have on. Some people prefer to have no collars if they have a dog that recalls and won't wander very far. If your dog cannot be let off the lead, please inform me before booking and we can discuss options.
- WEATHER: In the lead up to your photoshoot I'll be keeping a close eye on the weather, if I feel the photoshoot may need rearranged I'll get in touch. Rain and wind are usually the biggest problems and something I cannot shoot in. Soggy and windswept dogs are not a good look!
- BRIEF: I always welcome clients to let me know what sort of shots that they'd like, but don't forget it's usually down to what your dog will want to do on the day. Older dogs may not manage the full blown in the air running shots, the same as some breeds may not enjoy the water, making sea shots difficult. Photoshoots are all about capturing your dog's personality - so let them have a good time and I'll shoot away.

Photoshoot Terms and Conditions

By booking and taking part in a Rebecca Ashworth Photoshoot session you agree to the following photoshoot Terms and Conditions;

- If inclement weather or other adverse conditions prevent the photoshoot from taking place, another date will be arranged.
- Methods of Payment: Payment can be made by cash, BACS or PayPal. Gift vouchers must be paid for at the time of purchase. Photoshoots can be paid for at the time; or once preview images have been published.
- Pricing: The prices listed are in (GBP) Pound Sterling and include taxes. All prices are correct at time of publishing. They can be found via this [link](#).
- I reserve the right to use one or a selection of images from your shoot in any and all forms of media, for the purpose of self-promotion (Facebook, blogging etc), publicity, publishing, resale as prints or other media for commercial use, or in photographic contests or gallery shows. This includes use on stock sites. Any image containing a person that is easily recognisable will not be offered and will need written consent from that individual before being used.
- Waiver of liability: client expressly releases the photographer, her employees and agents from all claims, damages, and liabilities that may result from accidents or incidents that occur during the photo session. This waiver of liability includes waiver of any claim that may be a result of negligence.
- I retain copyright for all images taken on any photoshoot, except for pre-agreed commercial shoots. Images are sold on a personal use license, this includes those digitally. With the all inclusive packages you are able to make gifts and prints at home, however it is not permitted to sell them, edit them or enter them in to any competitions as your own. Permission may be granted to enter them into such competitions where they do not need to be 'your own work'.
- Uploading to Facebook; Where possible you must include the small watermark. If you cannot include the watermark (i.e. want to crop the photograph for a cover

photograph or profile photograph) please include in a comment a simple copyright notice - stating that I am the photographer. So for example - Image Copyright - Rebecca Ashworth at Sit Stay Capture. It is against my terms and conditions that you upload any high resolution file to the internet, other than for the purposes of ordering prints etc or to make gifts for yourself. It has become increasingly easy for people to steal images (especially via social media).

- NOTICE OF COPYRIGHT: all copyright of images taken on any photoshoot remains with Rebecca Ashworth Photography
- Refunds; Photoshoots are non-refundable. In the unlikely event of a compliant being made, a full review of the photoshoot will take place.
 - Gift Vouchers; Gift vouchers are non-refundable. They are valid for 18 months from purchase. It is the client's responsibility to book a date within that 18 month period, taking into account the possibility of rescheduling due to weather. Rescheduling or lack of an available date is not grounds for a refund. In the unlikely event that I, The Photographer must reschedule, I will email further dates (even if outside of the 18 month valid period) to ensure the photoshoot is completed. The client is wholly responsible for booking dates and correspondence with the photographer. Please note that during busy periods it may take several days to respond to enquiries. The voucher can be transferred should anything happen to the dog(s) it has been bought for. The voucher can only be used once and cannot be exchanged for cash. Only the original voucher is accepted. Vouchers cannot be used in conjunction with any other vouchers or offers.
